St Peter's Catholic School is delighted to announce that we are currently working towards the re-accreditation of the Quality in Careers Standard. The Standard is the national Careers Education Information Advice and Guidance (CEIAG) quality award.

The latest Statutory Guidance (January 2023) from the DfE to schools on fulfilling their statutory duty builds heavily upon the eight Gatsby Benchmarks for 'Good Careers Guidance' and 'strongly recommends' that all secondary schools work towards and achieve the national Quality in Careers Standard.

What are the benefits of achieving the Award?

- Successful achievement of the award demonstrates that we are providing excellent CEIAG for all our students and meeting our goal of ensuring that they are well-prepared for their next steps, whether education, training or employment.
- Quality standards lead to better careers and guidance programmes because they help schools continuously improve their careers work.
- Holding a nationally recognised quality mark demonstrates to those outside the institution that a high standard has been reached.

Re-accreditation will comprise providing a portfolio of evidence to our assessors and a full day inspection by an external registered assessor who will speak to staff, students, governors and other members of our school community about their experiences of CEIAG at St Peter's. Our links with our school community and wider school community are central to this process.
