
The Skiing

Skeleton Itinerary

First day: Flight from the Heathrow to Vienna.

Onward coach transfer to resort, check-in, ski equipment fit and dinner.

- Final day: Transfer back to airport for return flight & onward journey home

9.30am Meet with your instructors ready for morning ski lesson

12:00pm Lunch break (packed lunches)

1.00pm Afternoon ski lesson

3.30pm Return to the hotel to shower and relaxation

6pm Evening dinner

8pm Evening après-ski activity

10pm Lights out and sleep well




Ski Race & Presentation



Austria 2023 - Kit List

This is a check list of clothing and kit which you will need to bring with you. Please be aware that items with an asterisk next to them are essential and must be worn on the slopes to ski.

Non-Negotiables for the slopes

- Goggles *
- Waterproof ski jacket *
- Waterproof ski trousers *
- Waterproof gloves or mittens *
- •Two or three pairs of ski/board socks *
- •Two x thermal tops *
- •Two x fleeces *
- •Sunscreen high SPF *
- •Lip balm with SPF *
- Thermal bottoms *

Other kit to be considered

- Warm hat/beanie
- Sunglasses (optional and **not** instead of goggles)
- Neck warmer
- Day back pack
- Jeans/long trousers
- T-shirts/tops
- Jumper or fleece
- Underwear including socks
- Comfy trousers/jogging bottoms
- Shoes/boots with a good grip. No trainers to be worn on snow!
- Shoes for indoors / flip flops
- Sleepwear
- Toiletries including toothbrush
- Towel
- Swimming costume/trunks
- Any medication that is normally taken (enough for more than a week). Please make staff aware of any changes to previous information prior to departure.
- European charger adapter

Expectation of behaviour


- Every student will receive a copy of the Expectation of Behaviour 'contract'.
- 1 copy to be kept by the student and their adults and one copy to be kept by me.
- This will be a reminder of what we expect of every member of the group while we are away.
- This will then be signed by the adult, student and teacher.

Passports and EHIC/GHIC

- Thank you to all who have sent in the passport details.
- Those who have signalled that you have applied for a new passport, please keep me updated about the progress of it.
- I will need the passport details to send off to the tour operator latest beginning of term in January.
- Please send in (email is fine) a photocopy or a colour photo of the passport so I have a hard copy with me.
- If your European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) is still in date, they can be used in Europe.
- Alternatively, you can apply for Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC) that you can bring with you.
